## Relationships

Years ago, we might have said a few close relationships were enough—how wrong we were. God has called us to make disciples, and that means building relationships with both the lost and fellow believers. Some may respond to the Gospel quickly, but many need to see and hear it lived out over time. Recently, we attended a missions conference at Heritage Baptist Church and were encouraged by missionaries serving in Uruguay, Nepal, Greece, Micronesia, and Brazil. Their testimonies reminded us that we are not alone—and while we may face rejection, many face far greater risks. We are grateful for our freedom and challenged to use it faithfully.

That reminder about faithfulness in the face of rejection has been especially meaningful in our own journey. When we first began raising support, someone asked us, “If you had a button you could push to be fully funded, would you push it?” Back then, I would have said absolutely. But that button doesn’t exist—and we’re grateful it doesn’t. Over and over during this season, one theme has jumped out at us a million times: relationships matter. God has used support raising to grow our boldness and confidence in who He is, shaping us into better missionaries for Him. Each week we contact around 30 churches or individuals. Many don’t answer or don’t have time, and the rejection can be hard—but the conversations we do have are deeply encouraging. Support raising has also stretched us to be bold right here at home. It may not be movie season, but ministry never stops. Whether it’s our kids handing out a tract coin at a parade, offering to pray with someone at Dairy Queen, or sharing hope in a grocery store checkout line, God places people in our path every single day.
